Preparation Instructions

COOKING GUIDELINES. COOK BEFORE SERVING. For best results cook from frozen state. **CONVECTION OVEN:** Preheat oven to 375°F, high fan. Place frozen breadsticks on paper liner, using a full sheet pan. Bake at 375°F, low fan, for 10-12 minutes, until internal temperature reaches 160°F. For even cooking, rotate pans partway though baking time. Refrigerate or discard any unused portion. **NOTE:** Due to variances in oven regulators, cooking time and temperature may require adjustments.,, **CAUTION:** Breadstick will be hot. Allow breadsticks to cool a few minutes before serving.

Ingredients

Enriched flour (wheat flour, niacin, reduced iron, thiamine mononitrate, riboflavin, folic acid), reduced fat mozzarella cheese (pasteurized part-skim milk, nonfat milk, cheese cultures, modified corn starch*, salt, vitamin A palmitate, and enzymes), *ingredients not in regular mozzarella cheese, water, spice blend (non fat dry milk, dehydrated sweet cream(cream, nonfat milk, soy lecithin), modified food starch, whey protein concentrate, dehydrated butter (butter [cream, salt], nonfat milk, sodium caseinate, BHT [to protect freshness], salt, garlic powder, spice), soybean oil, sugar, salt, yeast, calcium sulfate, l-cysteine hydrochloride, ascorbic acid.
